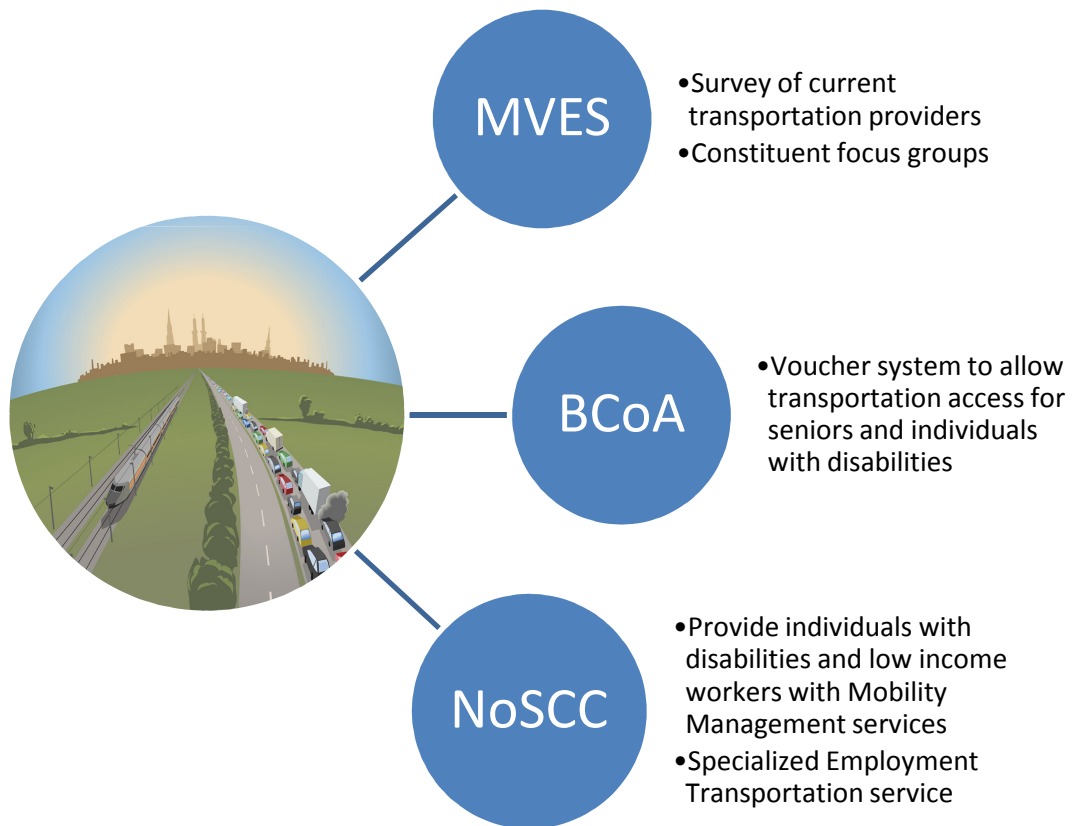


Involvement
